**Subject:** Regarding Meeting with ACMA

Dear Madam/Sir,

As you are aware, the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) is the National Standards Body of India, operating under the administrative control of the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Government of India. BIS is responsible for promoting harmonious development in standardization and related matters both domestically and internationally. In line with its mandate, BIS is engaged in the establishment, publication, review, and promotion of Indian Standards concerning goods, articles, processes, systems, and services.

BIS is also involved in the conformity assessment process through Quality Control Orders for products of public interest or those that protect human, animal, or plant health, ensure environmental safety, prevent unfair trade practices, or protect national security.

We are interested in understanding the perspective of Automotive Component Manufacturers regarding the import of components that are significant in number and adversely affect Indian industries. For such products, if standards exist, we may recommend that the relevant ministry to bring them under Quality Control Orders. Where Indian Standards are unavailable, we may initiate the process for standard formulation.

We want to hold the meeting with ACMA (along with one/two component manufacturers from various sectors as above) in physical mode at BIS HQ. The date of the meeting will be finalized once we receive your confirmation.
